

# Scriptures On Light & Darkness

## A. Scriptures in the Old Testament

1. For Thou dost light my lamp; The Lord my God illumines my darkness. (Ps. 18:28)
2. The Lord is my light and my salvation; who shall I fear? (Ps. 27:1)
3. For with Thee is the fountain of life; in Thy light we see light. (Ps. 36:9)
4. Oh send out Thy light and Thy truth, let them lead me ; Let them bring me to Thy holy hill, and to Thy dwelling places, Then I will go to the altar of God. . . (Psalm 43:3,4)
5. Thy word is a lamp to my feet, And a light to my path. (Ps. 119:105)
6. The unfolding of Thy words gives light. (Ps. 119:130a)
7. The people who walk in darkness will see a great light; Those who live in a dark land, the light will shine on them. (Is. 9:2)
8. And I will appoint you as a covenant to the people, As a light to the nations. To open blind eyes, to bring out prisoners from the dungeon; and those who dwell in darkness from the prison. (Is. 42:6b-7)
9. I will lead the blind by a way they do not know, in paths they do not know I will guide them, I will make darkness into light before them. (Is. 42:16a)
10. Saying to those who are bound, Go forth; to those who are in darkness, Show yourselves. (Is. 49:9a)

## B. Scriptures from the Gospels

1. The people who were sitting in darkness saw a great light, and to those who were sitting in the land and shadow of death, upon them a light dawned. (Mt. 4:16)
2. You are the light of the world . . . Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works and glorify your Father who is in heaven. (Mt. 5:14-16)
3. The lamp of the body is the eye; if therefore your eye is healthy, your whole body will be full of light. If your eye is bad, your whole body will be full of darkness (Mt. 6:22,23)
4. With which the Sunrise from on high shall visit us, To shine upon those who sit in darkness and the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace. (Luke 1:78. 79).
5. For my eyes have seen Thy salvation...A light of revelation to the Gentiles, and the glory of Thy people Israel. (Luke 2:30, 32)
6. In Him was the life, and the life was the light of men. and the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overpower it. (John 1:4,5)
7. There was the true light, which coming into the world enlightens every man. (John 1:9)
8. Light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than the light because their deeds are evil. For everyone who does evil hates the light, and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed. But he who practices the truth comes to the light, that his deeds may be manifested as having been wrought in God. (John 3:19-21).

9. I am the light of the world; he who follows Me shall not walk in the darkness, but shall have the light of life. (John 8:12).
10. Jesus therefore said to them . . . he who walks in the darkness does not know where he goes. . . believe in the light in order that you may become sons of light. (John 12:35-36)

### **C. Scriptures from Acts, the Epistles & Revelation**

1. To open their eyes so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the dominion of Satan to God, in order that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me. (Acts 26:18,23)
2. Wait until the Lord comes who will both bring to light, the things hidden in the darkness and disclose the motives of men's hearts. . . (I Cor. 4:5)
3. The god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving, that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God. (II Cor. 4:4)
4. For God who said, Light shall shine out of darkness, is the one who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ. (II Cor. 4:6)
5. I pray that their eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you may know what is the hope of His calling . . . (Eph. 1:18)
6. For you were formerly darkness, but now you are light in the Lord; walk as children of light. For the fruit of the light consists in all goodness and righteousness and truth (Eph. 5:8,9).
7. Do not participate in the unfruitful deeds of darkness, but instead even expose them. All things become visible when they are exposed by the light, for everything that becomes visible is light. (Eph. 5:11)
8. Giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in light. (Col. 1:12)
9. For you are all sons of light and sons of day. We are not of night nor of darkness; so then let us not sleep as others do. (I Thes. 5:5,6a)
10. Every good thing bestowed and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shifting shadow. (James 1:17)
11. The one who says he is in the light and yet hates his brother is in the darkness until now. (I John 2:9)
12. The one who loves his brother abides in the light and there is no cause for stumbling in him. The one who hates his brother is in the darkness and walks in the darkness, and does not know where his is going because the darkness has blinded his eyes (I John 2: 10,11)
13. God is light, and in Him there is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with Him and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth; but if we walk in the light as He Himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin. (I John 1:5-7)
14. The city has no need of the sun or of the moon to shine upon it, for the glory of God has illumined it, and its lamp is the Lamb. And the nations shall walk by its light . . . (Rev. 21:23)
15. For the Lord God shall illumine them . . . (Rev. 22:5)
